The Inhabitants of Concord Village or New Grant and the Proprietors Did Petition the Town of Concord to be Set of a Separat Town and accordingly they at a Generall Town meeting of the notable Inhabitants of Concord on Monday the fourth Day of march 1733/4 Mr Samuell Chandler was moderator of the meeting that in answer to the above named Petition Did set off the Village or Towns New Grant a Separat Town Together with Majorland Farms and the Inhabitants and Proprietors Did Petition the Grate and Generall Court for a Sanction and the Grate and Generall Court Did set off the Village Together with the Farms Caled with Charnes a separate ^{by the name of Acton} Town and ordered the Town to be Assembled in order to Chuse Town officers in the words following

In the House of Representatives June ye 27: 1735 ordered that John Heald one of the Principle Inhabitants of the Town of Acton in the County of middse Be and heareby is fully authorized and Impoured to assemble the freeholders and other qualified voters in the Town as soon as may be in some Convenient Place in said Town to make Choice of Town officers to stand till the anniversary meeting in march next
